A person is entitled to vote if he or she:

- Resides in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- Is a Canadian citizen;
- Is at least 18 years old; and
- Is not prohibited by any legislation from voting.

The 2014 Municipal Preliminary Voters List is available for inspection at the Clerk's Office, 8 Trunk Road in Spanish. Your name must be on the list to exercise your right to vote in the Municipal Elections. Applications for additions and corrections to the voters list can be made during normal office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday and until 8:00 p.m. on Voting Day, October 27th.

MAIL IN VOTING

Mail in Voting is once again being offered to qualified electors during the 2014 Municipal Elections. Applications are available at the Clerk's Office or can be faxed or e-mailed upon request. Applications may also be hand delivered in special circumstances. The application must be completed and returned with a copy of valid identification. Once the completed application has been received and approved by the Clerk, a ballot will be mailed to you to cast your vote and return to the Clerk's office. The secrecy of your ballot is assured. Nobody will know how you voted. Mail in ballots must be received at the Clerk's office by 8:00 p.m. on Voting Day – October 27th. Ballots received after this time cannot be counted.

PROXY VOTE CERTIFICATES

Proxy applications may be filed during normal hours of the Clerk's office commencing after 4:00 p.m. on September 15, 2014. On Advance Vote Day – Saturday, October 18, 2014 - the Clerk's office shall be open from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m. for proxy purposes.
