The Cemetery By-law states:

6.1 The Corporation reserves the right to remove all flowers, potted plants and wreaths when they become withered or unsightly, or for any other reasons such removals is in the best interest of the Cemetery.

A complete copy of the cemetery by-law is available up on request.

Please be advised that after November 11th the Caretaker will be removing all flowers, potted plants and wreaths and any other items that have been placed on grave sites. If you want to save these items, please remove them yourself prior to November 11th, otherwise they will be disposed of.

Demolition permits are also required. You must contact the Municipal Office before you build or demolish.
