2018 Municipal Elections

The next municipal election will be held on **October 22, 2018**. The Nomination period opens on **May 1, 2018** and closes on Nomination Day, **July 27, 2018 at 2:00 p.m.**

To run for office, you must be an eligible elector in the Town of Spanish. This means you must be:

- A Canadian Citizen
- At least 18 years of age
- Reside in the Municipality, or be the owner or tenant of land in the Municipality, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- Not prohibited from voting under any law

The Nomination must be on the prescribed forms, available at the municipal office and may be filed prior to Nomination Day anytime after May 1. Filing fees must accompany the form, as follows:

\$200 for the office of Mayor, and \$100 for all other offices.

A candidate may only run for one office, but should more than one nomination form be filed by a candidate, the last nomination filed will be deemed filed, and all previous nominations deemed withdrawn.


Nominations are certified or rejected by the Clerk on the Monday following Nomination Day. In 2018 that will be Monday, July 30, 2018.
