## **Winter Reminders:**

- Please refrain from parking on the streets in the winter months so the plow is able to clean the streets.

- If you are travelling this winter, please remember to make arrangements to have your driveway cleared in case emergency vehicles, i.e. fire trucks need to respond to a call.

## **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS**

An emergency is a situation that poses an immediate threat to human life or serious damage to, property. You should have a survival kit ready, food for 72 hours for everyone in the household and include games and activities to keep everyone busy. Also, pack a survival kit and food for your pet. Always listen to emergency workers especially if you are told to leave your home or workplace immediately.
