HOUSE FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- **Plan to use a neighbours phone to call 9-1-1**
- **Create a Fire Escape Plan and place where others can find it**
- **Practice escaping from EVERY room in the home**
- **IMMEDIATELY leave the home**
- **NEVER open doors that are too hot to the touch:** Use the back of your hand to feel the top of the door, the doorknob, and the crack between the door and the door frame. If it's hot, use your secondary escape route.
- **Get down low:** More people succumb to smoke and toxins in the air before burns. Always remember, "Bad air up, good air down. Stay low and go."
- **ONCE OUT, STAY OUT!** Designate a meeting place outside and take attendance. **NEVER** go back into the home.
- **Install working smoke detectors**

FIRE PERMITS

As of April 1st, **fire permits** are
required in the Town of Spanish.
Permits are available at no cost.
Permits are issued to property
owners only, tenants must present
written permission from the owner
to obtain a permit
