MUNICIPAL HAZARDOUS AND SPECIAL WASTE COLLECTION DAY



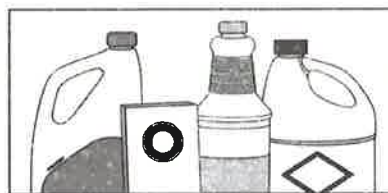
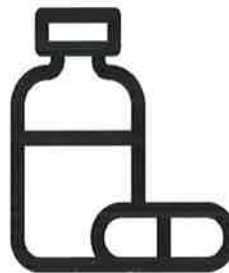

Accepted items include:

- Paints and stains
- Aerosols
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- Fire extinguishers
- Pool chemicals
- Pharmaceuticals
- Sharps
- Printer cartridges
- Oil and oil filters
- Automotive fluids and polishes
- Solvents
- Household cleaners
- Propane cylinders (1 kg)
- Fertilizers and pesticides
- Mercury thermostats
- Batteries- car and dry cell



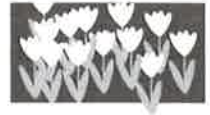
Items that will **not** be accepted include:

- Biomedical waste, flares, CO and smoke detectors, PCBs, ammunition, microwaves, asbestos, metal appliances

Please note that this collection is **only for residential waste.**

FRIDAY, MAY 31ST, 2019

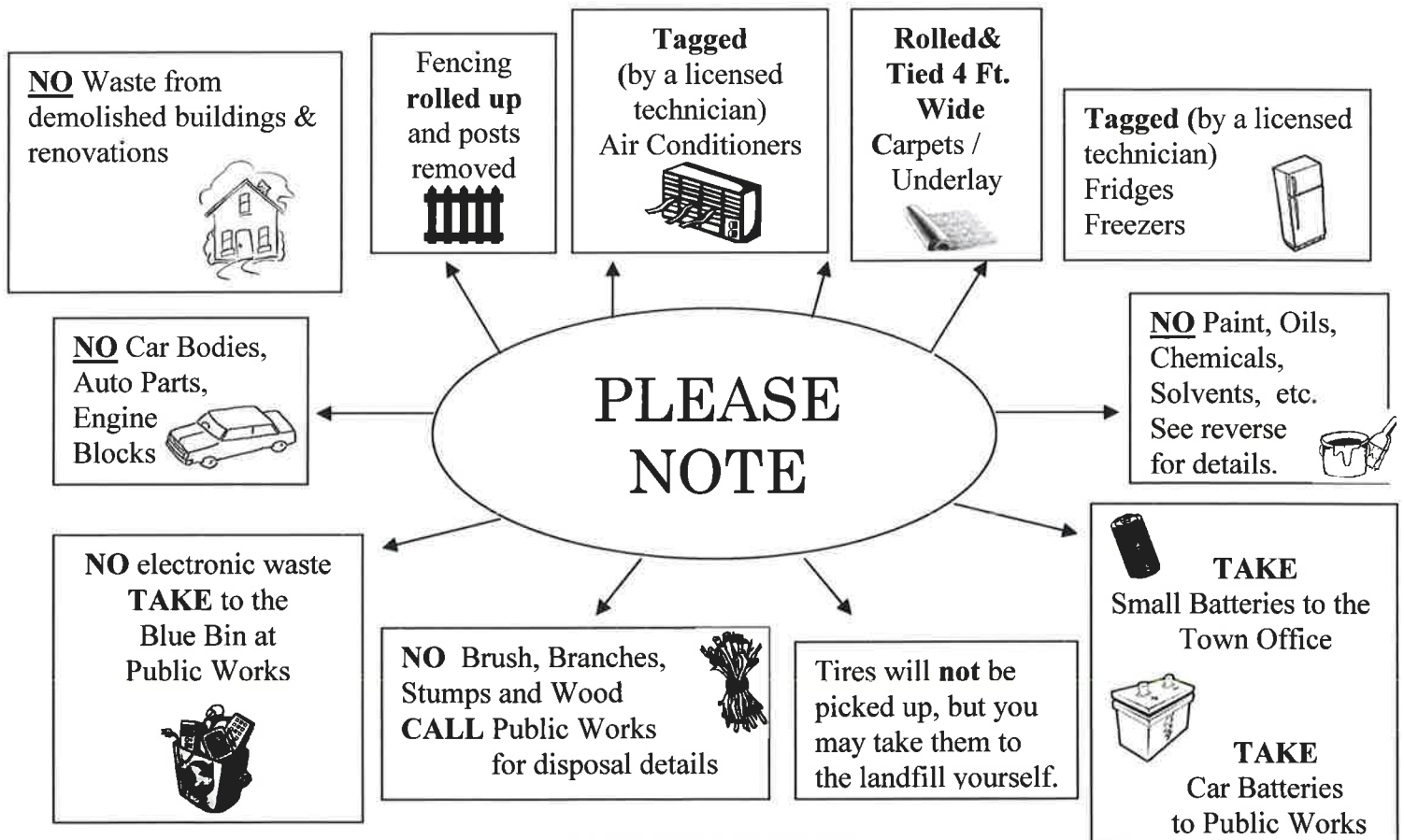


PLEASE HAVE YOUR GARBAGE OUT AT THE CURB BY **6:00 A.M.**
