BUILDING PERMIT Q & A

Q: Do you require a building permit when replacing old shingles with new ones?

A: **No, you do not require a permit to replace your shingles.**

Q: Do you require a permit when replacing shingles with a metal roof?

A: **Yes, you require a permit when replacing your shingles to a metal roof. The fees that will apply are \$50.00 for the permit fee and \$35.00 for the processing fee.**

Q: Do you need to apply for a building permit when replacing the siding on your home?

A: **Yes, you need to apply for a building permit. The fees that apply for the replacement of siding are \$40.00 for the permit fee and \$35.00 for processing fee.**

Q: Do I need to apply for a building permit when installing a pool, hot tub etc?

A: **Yes, pools that are capable of holding 24 inches or more of water require an enclosure for which a permit is required.**

HOUSE FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- Plan to use a neighbors phone to call 9-1-1
- Create a Fire Escape Plan and place where others can find it
- Practice escaping from EVERY room in the home
- **IMMEDIATELY** leave the home
- **NEVER open doors that are too hot to the touch:** Use the back of your hand to feel the top of the door, the doorknob, and the crack between the door and the door frame. If it's hot, use your secondary escape route.
- **Get down low:** More people succumb to smoke and toxins in the air before burns. Always remember, "Bad air up, good air down. Stay low and go."
- **ONCE OUT, STAY OUT!** Designate a meeting place outside and take attendance. **NEVER** go back into the home.
- **Install working smoke detectors**
