On August 23rd, The Honourable
Patty Hajdu, Minister of Employment,
Workforce Development and Labour,
Member of Parliament for Thunder Bay-
Superior North, on behalf of the
Honourable Bernadette Jordan, Minister
of Rural Economic Development, and
Jocelyne Bishop, Mayor of the
Municipality of Spanish announced
funding for six road and bridge
improvement projects in Northern
Ontario. In the Town of Spanish the
project will see the rehabilitation of
Algoma and Colonization Road; this will
include 1.2 km of roadway, including
