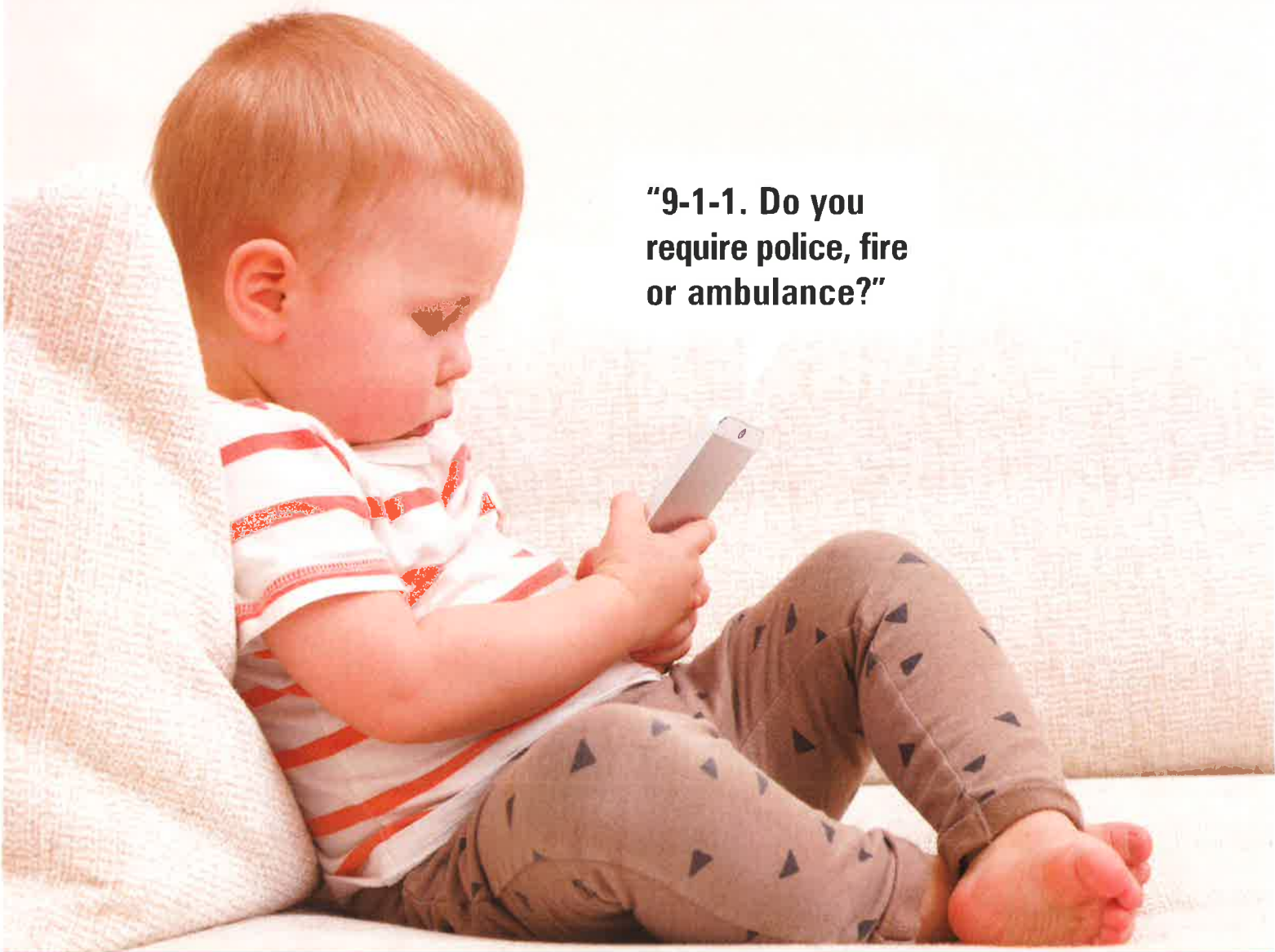

Only call 9-1-1 in emergencies.  
For non-emergencies, call 1-888-310-1122.

**Calling 9-1-1 is not child's play. Don't let children play with cell phones.**



**"9-1-1. Do you  
require police, fire  
or ambulance?"**

- Old, deactivated phones without a SIM Card can dial 9-1-1.
- If you or your child accidentally call 9-1-1, stay on the line.
- Every time an accidental or hang-up 9-1-1 call is received, police officers are dispatched.

***You may be taking a police officer away from a real emergency.***



**#KnowWhenToCall**

Lock the keypad on all your electronic devices before storing them.

“9-1-1. Do you require police, fire or ambulance?”

- If your electronic device dials 9-1-1, it will not register as a missed call.
- If you accidentally dialled 9-1-1, do not hang-up, stay on the line.
- Every time an accidental or hang-up 9-1-1 call is received, police officers are dispatched.
