NOTE: Fridges/Freezers must be decommissioned, tagged & certified by a licensed technician in order to be accepted at the landfill.



Can I have a backyard fire within the Town of Spanish?

The municipality does not issue permits for warmth or food, however the following conditions as noted in by-law #97-09 still apply:

Open air fires are not permitted between the hours of 8 am and 8 pm; A competent adult person must be present at all times;

Suppression tools (rake, shovel, adequate water) shall be present; The fire must be 5 metres from a forested area, 2 metres from any flammable material and 15 metres from any building.

No person shall set a fire in the open air which causes inconvenience or irritation to others.

Notice : Effective August 5, 2020, Council meetings will be reopening to the public, with certain safety precautions in place.

If more people register than the capacity of the council chambers (with physical distancing measures in place) the meeting may be relocated.

All attendees will be required to sign the register, use the hand washing station, practice physical distancing at all times and wear a mask or face covering. Council meetings are held the first and third Wednesday of each month and agendas and minutes are posted on the web-site.

The municipal office is currently closed to the public, but we are still available to assist you. Payments can be made online through most major financial institutions, or you can mail a cheque or money order, or drop your payment in the library book deposit at the front door of the municipal office.
