



6.16.2 NINTENDO SWITCH SYSTEM & GAMES (POLICY ACCEPTED BY RESOLUTION LB2018-5, FEBRUARY 27, 2018)

What is needed to borrow a Nintendo Switch system & games?

- A Nintendo Switch system & games may be checked out by a Spanish Public Library card holder and be in good standing (no outstanding fines, fees or overdue items) with the library. Photo ID and Proof of current address (if not on photo ID) must be provided.
- The user must sign a **Nintendo Switch Borrower's Agreement Form**. Patrons under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian sign out the Nintendo Switch System & Games.
- **Refundable deposit of \$20.00.**

Loan Period

- A Nintendo Switch System & Games can be checked out for 7 days
- The Nintendo Switch System & Games must be handed directly to staff when returned. **DO NOT RETURN IN THE BOOK DROP** as this may result in damage and the borrower paying the full replacement cost of the device.
- A Nintendo Switch System & Games can be renewed if there are no holds or a waiting list for them.

Fines

- Overdue fine for Nintendo System & Games is **\$20.00** per day.
- If a Video Game System & Games is more than **14** days overdue, or is returned damaged, the patron will be charged the replacement cost, which will include the cost of the Nintendo Switch System, all games, controllers, base, adapter & charging cord. The reason for this being that the library may not be able to replace the Nintendo Switch with the same type.
- If any parts and or cords are not returned, the appropriate replacement fees will be charged.

Security

- The Nintendo Switch may not be loaned to anyone else besides the borrower who signs the agreement.
- Please treat the Nintendo Switch System & Games with care, keeping it safe from liquids and from being dropped. Do not attempt to clean the Nintendo Switch with any chemicals or liquid.
- Tampering with the security features of the Nintendo Switch is prohibited and may result in suspension of e-reader borrowing privileges or payment for damages/replacement. Tampering includes, but is not limited to: hacking, cracking, modifications of any sort and copying of licensed games and software.
