### Message from the Mayor....

As we look forward to new beginnings with the approach of a new year, it seems a perfect time to reflect on the past year and the accomplishments of the Town and projects that we need to continue to push forward.

The departure of our long-time doctor saw Council and staff come together to work diligently on attracting a new physician, as well as locum doctors in the interim. As you may already know, Dr. Jessie Allison will commence practicing at the Spanish Medical Clinic on or about January 15, 2024 and Melanie Talbot will remain on staff to work with Dr. Allison.

The reconstruction of Algoma and Colonization Road was finalized in the summer of 2023. The scope of this work included sub-grade reinforcement, regrading, granular replacement and asphalt resurfacing, rock removal to allow for ditching, as well as a small storm sewer system to improve drainage and the surface water flow. Driveway and cross culverts were also replaced as part of the scope of the project.

Work commenced this Fall on Hamilton Street with the first phase being the replacement of manholes and some sanitary sewer and sanitary sewer lateral work. The next phase of work, scheduled for 2024 will include sub-grade reinforcement, regrading, granular replacement and asphalt resurfacing, along with improvements to the sidewalks and curbs.

Council and staff have been working since 2020 on a streetlighting project that will see improved lighting on Highway 17, from Anne Street to Short Street. On November 22, 2023, we finally received an Encroachment Permit from the Ministry of Transportation, which will enable this project to finally move forward in 2024.

The municipality has received funding to repair docks at the Spanish Municipal Marina. Piers 2 and 3 have been removed from the marina in their entirety and will have repairs conducted over the winter and placed back into the marina basin prior to the 2024 boating season.

2023 has been a rebuilding year for the Spanish Fire Department. We now have 8 firefighters and they have all been outfitted with new gear, and an agreement has been signed with the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers for Fire Chief services, which will continue until at least December 31, 2024. Practices are held weekly and the Spanish Fire Department works closely with the Walford and Massey Fire Stations. A Junior Firefighter Program has also been established and there are currently 3 active recruits 17 years of age and under, training and practicing with the Spanish Fire Department.

The landfill expansion project is also progressing. This is a slow process which involves working closely with the Ministry of the Environment, Parks and Conservation, as well as the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry.

The Council of the Town of Spanish would like to thank all volunteers who sit on municipal Boards and Committees. A big thank you to the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 576 and the Spanish Foodbank, the Spanish Horticultural Society, the Spanish River Snowmobile Club and to those individuals who make a difference without anyone ever knowing. Thank you to everyone who works to make our little town the best place in the world to live!

On behalf of all Council members and staff, we wish everyone a joyous, safe and healthy new year!


